ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Highland Township, about one mile north from Jordan High School, lying on the western side of State Highway No. 14. and on the northern side of a county surfaced road, being bounded on the north and northeast by lands of Ben Verdin, on the east by the said State Highway 14, and on the south and southwest by the said road and by another tract of myself being conveyed this day to Clark L. Verdin, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by will of my late husband, C. L.
