a point at the pump house on the northwest side of Laurel Creek.

It is further understood and agreed that the right-of-way to be used hereunder for the construction and maintenance of an electrical power line shall commence at the center of the Duke Power Company line northwest of Laurel Creek and running thence in a southernly direction 237.5 feet; thence southeasterly, approximately 50 feet to the pump house.

recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "EE", at Page 29, will more particularly show the location of the right-of-way for the four inch water main, the right-of-way for the 20 foot roadway, the right-of-way for the electrical power line, and the location of the water pump, pump house, intake crib, and catch basin, covered by this agreement.

The payment hereinabove specified covers compensation for the easements or, rights-of-way herein granted and also covers all claims for damages along said rights-of-way resulting from the construction of the water pipe line, roadway, power lines, and pumping station.
