All that piece, parcel, or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the Greer Mill Village, in or near the City of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot 178, as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision of Greer Mill Village, Creer, S. C.," made by Dalton and Neves, January 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book X at page set sex and x 205. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 205. Pennsylvania (Avenue) and fronts thereon ____120___ feet.

The granter and its predecessors in title have granted unto City of Greer, S. C., Southern Railway Company, Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, (other than house lines), electric light and power lines, including all pipe (other than house water and sewer lines) valves, fittings, hydrants, membeles, poles, power distribution, and sewerage systems of the village known as Green Mill Village in which the above described lot is located, together with rights of way and to relocate certain of such lines so as to run then in, along, above or near the streets and alleyways located in Green-Mill Village and to operation of the premises.

These is avoided and excluded from this construction and operation and/or the premises.

There is excepted and excluded from this conveyance so much of the personal property above mentioned as may be located upon the lot above described, and this conveyance is made subject to the rights of way and easements above mentioned insofar as they may affect said lot.
