All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in the Chick Springs Township, school district 9-C and containing 9.40 acres According to a plat thereof made on January 4, 1945 by W. J. more or less. Riddle and also as shown on a more recent plat dated August 20, 1953 entitled "Substation Lot of Duke Power Company" and having, according to said plats, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:
