- 8. No sewerage, refuse or garbage shall be deposited in any stream or lake, nor shall it be emptied into a disposal basin or tank located within 50 feet of any such stream or lake;
- 9. No stream on said land may be obstructed, or diverted in any manner;
- 10. No soil shall be excavated or trees removed from any lot except for that area to be built upon;
- 11. No lot shall be used for any purpose or in any manner which may constitute a nuisance;
- 12. No animals, except household pets, are permitted;
- 13. All mineral rights are reserved in the seller.
