RELEASE AGREEMENT

I, C. S. Brown, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred and seventeen and seventy-one hundredths (\$1,317.71) Dollars, Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars paid at the signing of this agreement and Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars payable on the first day of each succeeding month until the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars has been paid to me, and Three Hundred Seventeen and seventy-one hundredths (\$317.71) Dollars, payable to CLAY, CLAY & CLAY, Attorneys, to pay off due bills, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have hereby granted, bargained, sold and released unto Earle Blackwell, and his heirs and assigns, forever, all of my right, title and interest in and to one boxing or wrestling ring.

Also, as further consideration for the payment of said sums by Earle Blackwell, I do hereby release any and all rights which I now have to promote or sponsor wrestling matches in and around the City of Greenville, South Carolina so long as Earle Blackwell desires to promote or sponsor same.

Earle Blackwell, as further consideration for this release, does hereby release any and all rights which he now has to promote or sponsor boxing in and around the City of Greenville, South Carolina so long as C. S. Brown desires to promote or sponsor same.

Any debts incurred after the date of the execution of this release shall be paid by Earle Blackwell.
