FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy, sell, acquire, dispose of, deal and trade in and with, at retail or wholesale, new and used metals, metal products, scrap iron, scrap metals, salvage materials of all kinds, industrial waste of all kinds, surplus materials of all kinds, new and used machinery and machinery parts, pipes, paper, cloth, rags, new and used rubber; to wreck, demolish and acquire buildings and personal property of all kinds, for any purpose, including the p urpose of salvaging all junk, iron, metals, and any and all other articles therein contained; and generally to do any and all things necessary and proper pertaining to the conduct an operation of a scrap and waste business, including the owning and leasing of such real estate as may be necessary therefor; and generally to do any and all other acts and things which a corporation may do under the laws of the State of South Carolina
