- (13) It is agreed that the tenant reserves the right and privilege after payment of the rent at the expiration of the lease of removing any and all trade fixtures and other fixtures of a similar nature which may be installed by and at the expense of the tenant.
- (14) The Tenant is hereby given the privilege to erect, maintain, and use any signs on the leased premises, including hanging or extension electric signs, the supports of which may be attached to the upper or other part of the building of which the premises leased are a part; provided, that the same shall comply with the laws, ordinances, and regulations applicable thereto, of the city, county, and state in which the leased premises are situated. The landlords covenant to co-operate with the tenant for the purpose of obtaining any permit, license, or consent that may be necessary for the erection and maintenance of such signs.
- (15) The Landlords covenant and agree that the tenant, upon paying the rent herein reserved, and upon performance of the covenants and agreements herein provided to be observed and performed by him, shall peaceably and quietly hold and enjoy the demised premises for the term aforesaid.
