NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars in hand paid to Willie Maude Phillips Smith by David C. Phillips and in further consideration of the premises contained herein and of natural love and affection, the said Willie Maude Phillips Smith, hereinafter called Smith, and David C. Phillips, hereinafter called Phillips, do hereby enter into the contract.

WITNESSETH

Upon the death of said W. M. Phillips, Smith agrees to convey real estate to Phillips, his heirs or assigns, as hereinafter stated.

1. In the event that it has not been necessary to convey any of the land described in the above referenced deed for the support, comfort, health and well being of W. M. Phillips, Smith does hereby bargain, covenant, agree and contract to convey the following-described property:
