Commencing on a stake near Middle River Meeting House, running thence S. 37 W. 3.65 chs. to a post oak; thence S. 53 E. 3.25 chs. to a stake; thence N. 37 E. to the public road: thence with the public road to the beginning corner, containing one acre more or less.

Being the same property conveyed by J. H. Cleveland to "F. R. Bates, Thomas Clark, and E. F. Reynolds as trustees, and their successors for the purpose of permanently locating a school in Cleveland Township", by deed dated December 4, 1883, recorded in Plat Book PP at Page 425; the said school site was abandoned by the school district many years ago and was acquired by M. L.
