POWER OF ATTORNE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Paul Edgeworth Blythe, of the State and County aforesaid, do hereby constitute and appoint my wife, Gilda Rae Blythe, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, with full power to have and exercise the following powers and authorities:

- (4) To collect any monies which may become due me and to give receipts therefor;
- (5) To be my lawful proxy and to vote any stock or security I may own or may hereafter own and to exercise all powers, privileges, and options I myself might exercise as owner of said stocks and securities;
- (6) To invest and reinvest from time to time any funds I may have in her absolute discretion;
- (7) And, generally, to manage and control my proterties, and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose
