

All of that parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located about one-half mile South from the new City limits of Greer, known and designated as Lot No. 40 on a plat of property known as Pleasant Heights Development made by H.L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 4, 1950, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake on the South side of Grove Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 39 and 40 on said plat, and runs thence with the common line of said lots S. 5.00 W. 185 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 49; thence with the line of Lot No. 49 S. 84.30 E. 100 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots Nos. 40 and 41; thence with the common line of these lots N. 5.00 E. 185 feet to a stake on the South side of Grove Street; thence along said street N. 84.30 W. 100 feet to the beinning corner, and being all of that lot of land conveyed to the grantor by L.C. Pearson by deed dated September 13, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 463, at page 249.
