"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 43.20 acres, more or less, known as part of the Hood Davenport Place and being part of the lands described in paragraph three of the first codicil of the last will and testament of James Scott filed in the office of the Probate Judge of Greenville County in Apartment 128, File 30. Said lands being bounded on the North by lands now or formerly owned by Spearman and known as the old Holliday Place; on the East by the public rose and the lands of Enore Childress; on the South by lands of G. C. Childress; and on the West by lands of Frank Mahaffey, the lands have the following courses and distances as will more fully appear by reference to a plat of survey made by N.
