

Greenville Motor Boat Club Inc." made by Bulton & Neves, June 1953, and recorded in the office for Greenville County, S.C. in plat book "F", pages 30 and 31, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Begging at an iron pin on the Southeasterly side of Club Circle, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, and running thence along the southeasterly side of Club Circle S 39-51 W 25 feet to an iron pin, joint of lots Nos. 56 and 57; Thence along the common line of said lots S 50-20 E. 63.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northwesterly bank of Saluda River; thence along the northwesterly bank of Saluda River N 24-30 E 25 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence along the common line of said lots N 49-17 W 25 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
