Sarah Evelyn Jarrell (same as Evelyn W. Jarrell) an undivided 1/32 interest for life and upon her death, said 1/32 interest to vest in her children, share and share alike, in fee, under the terms of Item IV of the last will and testament of Lula Gibson Long, deceased, dated September 21, 1923, filed in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C. in Apartment 187, File 8,

Mark W. Cauble, Executor of the Estate of Gladys C. Barton, deceased, an undivided 1/12 interest in fee, to be held, administered and disposed of under the terms of Items III and IV of the last will and testament of Gladys C.
