THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1954 by and between Dick Fortune, hereinbefore called Lessor, and Edward W. Clay and Ned P. Clay, partners in trade under the name and style of Clay Bros. Drug Store, hereinafter called Lessees;

LEASEHOLD TERM:

I. The Lessor hereby grants, bargains, and leases to the Lessees, the business building located at 503 Green Avenue in or near the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, which is immediately adjacent to the building now occupied by Clay Bros. Drug Store, and including a storeroom or service building in the rear of said buildings which front on Green Avenue, for a period of five (5) years beginning at the second day of June 1954, or until the first day of June 1959, with the right of the Lessees to exercise an option hereby given and in the manner set forth, in consideration of the promises and a renteite of the sum of certain contained in their payment of the amount of one thousand and one hundred five dollars herein stated, to pay to the Lessor of said buildings of property herein described at the annual rental rate for an additional period of five (5) years commencing the first day of June 1954, provided that the Lessees shall notify the Lessor on or before the first day of June if they desire to exercise their option to renew for an additional five year period; upon the Lessees so doing, for the use and occupancy of said buildings for the purpose of business hereinafter referred to in this instrument, namely, the sum of fifty (\$50.00) dollars per month, payable in advance, first day of each and every month, for the period from June 1954 until the expiration of this lease.
