presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. R. Turner, Sr., and C. R. Turner, Jr., their heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, containing 256 acres, more or less, and hav-  
ing the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

pine stump; thence N. 6 E., crossing a public road, 10.40 chs. to  
an iron pin; thence S. 74 E., 10.40 chs. to a stake on Maple Creek;  
thence along said Creek as the line, S. 5-45 E., 2.79 chs.; S. 15  
E., 6.10 chs.; S. 12-30 E., 4.40 chs. to a stake on Maple Creek;  
thence N. 56 E., 1.24 chs. to stone; thence S. 23 E., 5.03 chs. to  
a stake; thence S. 63 E., 12.89 chs. to a stake on branch; thence  
down said branch as a line, S. 35 W., 3.48 chs.; S. 57-30 W., 2.07  
chs.; S. 82-15 W., 2.54 chs.; S. 42-30 W., 5.03 chs.; S. 56 W.,  
0.85 chs.; S. 25-30 W., 1.30 chs.; S. 31-40 W., 1.24 chs. to the in-  
tersection of said branch and Maple Creek; thence along Maple Creek  
as a line, by traverse line, the following courses and distances:  
S. 50-35 E., 2.49 chs.; S. 6-15 W., 2.77 chs.; S. 53-30 W., 1.17  
chs.; S. 45 W., 2.30 chs.; S. 13-30 E., 4.15 chs.; N. 55-30 E.,  
3.13 chs.; S. 56-10 E., 3.73 chs.; S. 15-45 W., 4.22 chs.; S. 31-30  
W., 5.44 chs.; S. 18-45 W., 2.13 chs.; to the intersection of  
spring branch and Maple Creek; thence up said branch as the line,  
S. 70-30 E., 1.34 chs.; S. 75-30 E., 2.27 chs.; S. 70 E., 2.00 chs.;  
S. 2-30 W., 1.18 chs.; S. 47-35 E., 1.52 chs.; to a stone; thence  
S. 53-45 W., 6.60 chs.; thence S. 30-15 W., 6.90 chs. to Reedy  
Creek; thence along Maple Creek as the line, 17.00 chs. to the  
point of beginning, less, however, a tract of 41.5 acres heretofore  
conveyed by C. L. Gresham to Mattie and Harold Dutton, as recorded  
in the R.L.C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 313, page  
39.
