To purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation or corporations organized under the laws of this state or any other state, country, nation or government, and while the owner thereof to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote.

To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind, and description with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, county, state, territory politic or government or colony or dependency thereof.

To borrow money for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the corporation and from time to time, without limit as to amount, to make, accept, enclose and issue promissory notes, bonds and other evidences of debt and to secure the payment of any of its obligations by contract or deed in trust on all or any of its property and franchises, both real and personal.

To have one or more officers, to carry on all or any of its operations and amount to  
amount as without restriction or limit as to purchase or otherwise acquire,  
hold, own, maintain, sell, convey, or distribute shares of real and personal  
property of any kind, either in this corporation and any of the States,  
Districts, Territories, or Colonies of the United States, and in any and all  
foreign countries, subject to such laws as may, in District Territories,  
as may be enacted.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of this state upon corporations formed under the act hereinafter referred to, and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the extent as natural persons might or could do.

The objects and purposes specified in the foregoing clauses shall, except where otherwise expressed, be lawfully used and restricted by the corporation, or otherwise freely, to the end that they may be used in the administration of its charter, but the objects and purposes specified in each of the preceding clauses of this article shall be construed as including the objects and purposes.
