Hallman, Jr. is acknowledged to be the owner of a thirty (30%) per cent undivided interest in the said property, and

WHEREAS, it is the wish, desire and intent of the owners by this instrument to prescribe certain covenants to run with the land with respect to the disposition or transfer of their respective interests therein,
