


(also known as Chick Springs Road) and designated as Lots 1, 2, and 3 as shown on a plat made by W. D. Neves, December 23, 1914 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at Page 236, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
