- 4. To execute and deliver leases on all or any part of the property herein conveyed on such terms and conditions and for such length of time as in the sole discretion of the Trustee may appear proper;
- 5. To execute any instrument conveying a right-of-way or easement for street, highway or utility purpose over and across said property:
