- (2) No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the above described lot until the building plans, specifications, and plot plan showing the location of such building have been approved in writing as to conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures in the subdivision, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevations by the grantors herein.
