

... I WITNESS, KNOW ALL THIS BY THESE PRESENTS, That  
in view of the mutual considerations to be arrived by all of  
said parties hereto, it is hereby agreed by, between and among  
said parties hereto, that wall o' the building of Charles H.  
Spence, Roy L. Boggess an' Kelvin L. Younts just extend six  
(6) inches, for the length of said building, on the property  
of Alexander C. Crouch an' that running in a easterly direction  
a. Crouch right attach to said wall for the purpose of connecting  
a building adjacent to and adjoining thereto; Alexander C.  
Crouch to a hereby grant, five and convey unto Charles H.  
Spence, Roy L. Boggess and Kelvin L. Younts the necessary right  
of way and/or easement to construct said joint property wall  
six (6) inches on his property along his eastern side boundary  
line. In addition thereto Alexander C. Crouch does hereby  
grant, five and convey the necessary right of way and/or  
easement in that certain parcel of land approximately fourteen  
and one-half (14-1/2) feet wide bein' the easternmost fourteen  
and one-half (14-1/2) feet of the property of Alexander C.  
Crouch for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining  
and repairing said storm sewer system. Said Charles H. Spence,  
Roy L. Boggess and Kelvin L. Younts, to hereby convey, five  
and one-half (5-1/2) feet unto Alexander C. Crouch the necessary right of way  
and/or easement to attach to wall o' the above mentioned  
said wall o' property wall. It being understood that such wall  
shall be constructed six (6) inches upon the property of  
Alexander C. Crouch a. a. (6) inches upon the property of  
Charles H. Spence, Roy L. Boggess and Kelvin L. Younts, said  
wall being a total of twelve (12) inches in width. In addition  
thereto, Charles H. Spence, Roy L. Boggess and Kelvin L. Younts  
do hereby grant, convey and give unto Alexander C. Crouch the  
necessary right of way and/or easement over and across and under  
that thirty-five (35) foot strip of land lying between West  
North Street and the front of said building, to be constructed,  
for the purpose of installing, maintaining, and repairing, a  
storm sewer system, it being the intention that said system
