

ALL that lot of land situate on the West side of Scarlett Street (formerly known as Forest Green Road) partly inside and partly outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 227 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book GG, pages 70 and 71, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Scarlett Street at joint front corner of Lots 226 and 227 and running thence along the line of Lot 226, N. 76-44 W., 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13-16 E., 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 228, S. 76-44 E., 175 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Scarlett Street; thence with the West side of Scarlett Street, S. 13-16 W., 75 feet to the beginning corner.
