

and free right, liberty and authority to construct, operate and maintain a one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) inch water line under the ground along the edge of Unity Road, from the city limits of the town of Mount Pleasant to one thousand (1000) feet beyond a point where Lee Town Road and Unity Road intersect and one thousand (1000) feet in each direction along Lee Town Road, from the point where Unity Road crosses Webb Town Road and the county further agrees to permit Unity Water Co., its successors or assigns, to dig the necessary ditches for the laying of the one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) inch water line and to make any excavations necessary for the construction and permanent maintenance of said water line.

III.

The said Water Co., composed of the above named several persons, agrees to bind themselves individually, jointly and severally, to do as little damage as possible to the road side of the county's road and further agrees to restore the county's road or road side to the equivalent condition that it was before any excavations for construction or maintenance was made, now and in the future, and, further agrees that the county shall not be responsible for any damages, now or in the future that may be done or caused by the county, when the county is in the process of maintaining or improving the county's road or road side and is employing due care in such operation.
