All wur right, title and interest in and to a certain parcel of land lying on the Pelzer Sandy Springs Church Road in the Sandy Springs Church community, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being a portion of the lands formerly owned by D. L. Garrison and Betty Garrison and having been acquired by them under the will of their mother, Sally D. Garrison and containing 43.07 acres, more or less, according to a survey made by C. O. Riddle, Reg. Land Surveyor, in January 1955. It begins in the center of the Pelzer-Sandy Springs Church Road a distance of 175 feet northeast from the lands of W. H. Campbell which beginning point is the northeast corner of a lot owned by Roy W.
