"All that piece, percel and tract of land lying and being in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, just south of the Town of Simpsonville and being a portion of the lands conveyed to B. H. Richardson by Roy West and others by deed dated November 22, 1935, recorded in Deed Book 182, Page 138. It begins at an iron pin at corner of lands of E. M. Goodnough and runs thence S. 1-17 W. 107.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 77-53 E. 316.5 feet crossing the Fairview Road and extending to the edge of the C. & W. C. Railway; thence on the same course 14 feet to center of the said C. & W. C.
