presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. Commission of Public Works of the City of Greer, their Successors and Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal

Township, Greenville

County State of South Carolina, containing 2.87 Acres, more or less, and having courses and distances according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated January, 1955, as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the lot herein conveyed, corner of P.D. Hudson, and running thence along the line of P.D. Hudson and E.G. Ballenger, N. 14.00 W. 244 feet to a stake; thence S. 26.10 W. 358 feet to a stake near branch; thence N. 83.20 W. 445 feet to a stake; thence N. 53.20 W. 180 feet to a stake at Groce Meadow Road; thence along said road, S. 9.30 E. 150 feet to a stake; thence S. 84.05 E. 265 feet to a stake; thence S. 58.15 E. 157 feet to a stake; thence S. 41.00 E. 126 feet to a stake; thence S. 38.00 E. 294 feet to a stake at branch; thence N. 4.20 W. 351 feet to a stake; thence N. 12.20 E. 175 feet to a stake; thence S. 85.15 E. 112 feet to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the described property, along with other parcels on South Tyger River, is to be used by the Commission of Public Works for a water shed and reservoir for the City of Greer. The seller herein, as long as he owns the adjoining tract from which the above described tract is conveyed, or the subsequent owners of the same, shall have the following rights and privileges, but subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. To pasture to the water line, or to cultivate crops to the high water mark in flood season; to withdraw water for irrigation purposes when the same is available, subject to State laws and regulations.
- 2. To fish in the waters of the reservoir, subject to the laws of the State and the rules of the S.C. Fish and Game Commission and the rules of the Commission of Public Works.
- 3. To use boate upon the reservoir, but no motors used thereon shall exceed three (3) horsepower.
