in each deed executed by J. E. Gilliam, Jr., and by subsequent grantors, to each of us as above set forth, which restriction is as follows: "(3) This lot shall never be owned by any person of African descent," is and the same shall be henceforth null and void, of no effect whatsoever, and completely inoperative, it being our intent to rescind said restriction as though the same had never been imposed.
