RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO SECTION II OF OAK CREST, A SUBDIVISION OF LAND IN GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA

There are hereby imposed upon Section II of Oak Creat, a subdivision of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, which is the property of Brown, Inc., the restrictions set forth below for the nutual benefit of the undersigned and of all other persons who may hereafter acquire property in this subdivision.

as Section II of Oak Crest according to a plat of C. C. Jones which is to be recorded, and is a portion of the land conveyed to brown, Inc. by Leonge F. Townes, Individually and as Trustee by his deed dated January 21, 1955. The land conveyed in that deed lies on both sides of a branch which runs from the northern side of the tract to the section side, dividing the tract into two areas of roughly equal size.

The portion of said tract lying on the eastern side of the brown is land made as Section II of Oak Crest and it is to this land that these restrictions apply. The land lying on the western side of the brown is dustinated as Section I and is not subject to the restrictions apply this instrument. (See restrictions and amended restrictions of record applicable to Section I.)

Nothing herein shall be construed, however, as denying the right of lot owners after January 1, 1976 to continue said restrictions or other restrictions by appropriate action.
