WHEREAS, the City of Greenville, S. C., has been granted the right to construct a water distribution system and to sell water to the City of Greenville, S. C., and

WHEREAS, said corporation has applied to the County of Greenville County, directed to place its application before the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 1900, the duly elected commissioners of Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., authorized the sale and distribution of water to the County of Greenville, and

WHEREAS, the said Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-nine and 01/100 (\$1,290.00) paid to the said commissioners, did then and there enter into a sewer district, specifically described as follows:

Any and all of the facilities used in connection with the water distribution system, now or hereafter owned by Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., situated on or near Edwards road just west of the city limits of Greenville, S. C., including all water tanks, pipe, pipe lines, valves, fittings, pumps, reservoirs and any and all tanks necessary for holding concrete.

AND: Any and all franchises, rights, privileges or rights of way now owned or held by Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., in connection with its water distribution system.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said property herein described, the said Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., its successors and assigns,

and the said Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., for its heirs, successors and assigns, covenants with the said Wade Hampton Water & Sewer District that it is the lawful owner of said water distribution system and has good right to sell the same as aforesaid; that the said is true from encumbrances and that said Edwards Road Water Co., Inc., will warrant and defend the same against all persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

I. WILL SIGN OFF the said certificate and have it countersigned and sealed to be heretounto attested and these presents to be acknowledged by its duly authorized officers, S. A. Brech, resident, and D. A. Timmons, Jr., secretary, on this the 31st of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-five, in the one hundred and twenty-ninth year of the sovereignty of the United States of America.
