Beginning at an iron pin, northeast corner of said lot and on line of the W.P. Smith tract, and running thence N. 53.10 W. 60 feet to an iron pin on line of the Searcy lot; thence along line of same, S. 34.15 W. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57.57 E. 59.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34.15 E. 25 feet to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the described property, along with other parcels on South Tyger River, is to be used by the Commission of Public Works for a water shed and reservoir for the City of Greer. The seller herein, as long as he owns the adjoining lot from which the above described lot is conveyed, of the subsequent owners of the same, shall have the following rights and privileges, but subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. To pasture to the water line, or to cultivate crops to the high water mark in flood season; to withdraw water for irrigation purposes when the same is available, subject to State laws and regulations.
- 2. To fish in the waters of the reservoir, subject to the laws of the State and the rules of the S.C. Fish and Game Commission and the rules of the Commission of Public Works.
- 3. To use boats upon the reservoir, but no motors used thereon shall exceed three (3) horsepower.
