## CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS.

CLARENCE EARLEY and BILL EARLEY

Greer, South Carolina

did on the

, 19 55 , file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is EARLEY AUTO SUPPLY, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is in Greer, South Carolina in the County of Greenville.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in the business of wholesaling and retailing of automobile parts, tractor, truck and other machine parts, to make repairs thereto; to wholesale and retail any and all accesories and merchandise related to motor vehicles and other machinery and any other varied and sundry merchandise.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Forty Thousand (C40,000.00)----- Dollars payable as follows: Twenty-one Thousand (221,000.00) dollars on perfection of the corporation. (210 shares of stock to be issued on completion of organization).

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Four Hundred (400)

of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----Dollars.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greer Citizen
