CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, DAVID S. GOLDBERG AND ROBERT M. HOLLINGS

both of Charleston, S. C.

did on the 29th. day of April, 1952, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is AUTO SERVICES, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Avondale, Charleston County, SOUTH CAROLINA

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is
