THE PROTECTIVE COVENANTS HEREINAFTER set forth shall pertain to all lots in that certain tract of land near the City of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown on a plat of Berea Heights Addition, Property of R. W. Jones, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "S" at Page 102.

- (1) The property shall be used for residential purposes only.
- (2) No dwelling shall be erected on said property with less than 1100 square feet floor space, exclusive of porches and attached garage or other structure.
- (3) Each dwelling shall have approved composition roof, and shall have 24 inches clearance off the ground at the lowest point.
- (4) Each dwelling shall be set back from the street at least 40 feet, and shall be in line with other dwellings which may be over 40 feet from the street.
