timber of six inches or more at the stump on the following described
property:

four miles west of Marietta, containing 8 acres, more or less, containing
property of Maude Adams, Milt Bates, and James E. Taylor.

It is agreed that the grantee shall have until January 1, 1946, to
which to remove said timber.

It is further agreed that the grantee may cut down and remove by
such means of ingress and egress as may be necessary for the cutting and
removing of said timber, and the consideration for this deed includes any
damages or injuries to my land in said cutting and removal of said trees.

We do represent and warrant that we are the owners of said property with
full authority to execute this timber deed.
