Subject, however, to the following restrictions:

- Siad property shall be used only for residential purposes;
- And shall never be sold, rented or disposed of to persons of African descent; and,
- No residence shall be erected on lot 15 costing less than \$2,500.00.

Subject, also, to the easement of the Duke Power Company, acquired through deed of William B. Feltman, dated February 13, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 340 at page 223.

All property taxes on said property are paid up to and through 1954. Taxes on said property for 1955 are pro-rated, and are to be paid by grantees. But no other obligation is assumed by the grantees, said property being clear of all liens and encumbrances whatseover.
