of the grantee continue to use the old transformer location for necessary meters, apparatus and equipment for serving said Pleasantburg Shopping Center and vicinity, and that the granter, its successors and assigns shall provide in or through its premises right-of-way for ingress and egress of employes of the grantee, its successors or assigns, for the purpose of reading, testing and maintaining said meters.

The grantor herein agrees that in the event it is notified of the intention of the grantee of the necessity of moving its transformer station and grantor fails to provide secondary line and right-of-way to meter vault as herein provided within thirty (30) days after such notice, the grantor, its successors or assigns, will indemnify and save harmless the grantee, its successors or assigns, from any and all damages, claims and expense resulting from failure to do so.
