The transfer of title and execution of the note and mortgage as above provided shall be made on or before January 10, 1956 and in the event an examination of the title should reveal that the title is for any reason whatsoever unmarketable this Contract shall then be rull and void and of no further offect and all sums paid hereunder by the purchaser shall be returned. Otherwise should the purchaser fail to perform his part of this agreement then such sums as shall have been paid hereunder may be retained by the seller as liquidated damages.
