


NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I. E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County

of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents. DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said J. D. Green, Jr. and Parie Lee Green, their heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Scuffletown Road, about five (5) miles Southeast of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pin on the Northern edge of the said Scuffletown Road or Woodruff Road opposite Conyers and Gower property, said pin being the corner of Lizzie Griffith's land and running thence along the line of said Lizzie Griffith's land N. 16-45 W. 871 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin at a ditch; thence S. 16-45 E. 779 feet to an iron pin on the Northern bank of said Scuffletown Road; thence along said road S. 83-45 E. 220 feet to the beginning point and containing 3.78 acres, more or less.

The consideration for this conveyance is \$8,000.00, which consideration has been paid to the plaintiff as directed by the Court.
