



All those pieces, parcels or lots of land with all buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

Lot 6, Wildwood Park, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "O", page 161, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the old Greenville-Hendersonville Highway at the corner of Lot 5; themce along the line of Lot 5 S. 81 E. 150 feet to a holly; thence N. 12 E. 110 feet; thence N. 81 W. 150 feet to a point on the said Highway; thence along the East side of said Highway S.  $17\frac{1}{2}$  W. 90 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Edgar S. Burry and Ellen H. Burry by deed of Meares and Davis dated September 18, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 280, at page 256.

Also Tract 9 of Section D, of Carolina Lake Colony according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book Y, pages 126 and 127.

This is the same property conveyed to E. S. Burry by deed of Carolina Lake Colony, Inc., dated July 23, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 460, page 264.

The said E. S. Burry died testate on December 6, 1952, leaving a will which is recorded in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 616, File 14. The Grantor herein, Ellen H. Burry, is the widow of the said E. S. Burry and the property conveyed herein was devised to her by the terms of the will referred to above.

Also all interest which the Grantor has in and to any lands lying within the boundaries of any road or street, adjacent to, bounding or running through the above described property.

Also all interest which the Grantor has in or to any lake and strip of land adjacent thereto and any right the Grantor has to use and enjoy the same, adjoining the above described property in Carolina Lake Colony.
