In the event of the sale of the premises herein described, these restrictions shall cease and the trustees thereby enabled to give a good and sufficient deed, provided the consent of the Grantor is obtained as provided under No. 4 of the restrictions hereinabove set forth.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named/ ~~and~~ Annie Mae Lyda, Thomas R. Julian, and Thomas H. Mahaffey, as Trustees of Wesleyan Methodist Church, Fountain Inn, ~~and~~ and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever South Carolina, their successors lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
