

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WE, MARY B. BROOKSHIRE LINDY, LETHA REILLY BROOKSHIRE YEOMANS, HAROLD H. BROOKSHIRE and MILLIE FAY BROOKSHIRE GRUMBLE, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Two Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, all of our right, title and interest in and to:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the South side of U. S. Highway 25 (Suncombe Road) being a part of Lot 16 on the plan of property of R. G. Bellenger, recorded in the EMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat book "D", page 210, containing 12.16 acres, and having the following description:

BEGGING at a stake on the South side of pavement or road of highway and running thence S. 6-70 E., 1054 feet to a stake in line of Lot 17; thence along line of Lot 17, S. 55-30 W. 17 feet to a stone; thence S. 42 W., 128 feet to a stake; thence S. 33 W., 220 feet to a stake; thence N. 6-30 E. 1230 feet to stake on the South side of said highway; thence in an Easterly direction, a line running along a line, 420 feet to the beginning point.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to W. L. Lindy by Deed to J. V. Lummon dated November 14, 1941, rec'd in the Office of the Clerk for Greenville County, S. C., in Book 242, page 712. W. L. Lindy died testate, a resident of Greenville, S. C., on April 24, 1954, his will having been admitted to probate on May 1, 1954, Department 530, Office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville County, S. C. The Grantors herein are the widow and the children of W. L. Brookshire. The remaining interest in the above property is held by the wife of W. L. Brookshire, Francis Brookshire, it being conveyed to the City of Greenville, S. C., by L. M. Lindy, Master for Greenville County, S. C., pursuant to a decree of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County, S. C., in the case of Mary M. Brookshire Lindy, et al against Francis Brookshire, referenced to the date of judgment Roll G4272 on file in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, S. C.
