




No/100 (\$10.00) and to ...us..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. L. Alexander (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. L. ALEXANDER, his neigh and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of West Parker Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of West Parker Road, at corner of lot now or formerly of Edward F. Cranford and Lois W. Cranford, and running thence along said Cranford line, N 56-30 E, 193.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 31-0 E, 135.62 feet to an iron pin at corner of property now or formerly of Ossie Hunt; thence along said Hunt line, S 56-30 W, 207.24 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of West Parker Road; thence along the Northeast side of Mest Parker Road, N 26-W, 134.3 feet to the beginning corner

C., in Deed Book 216, at page 34, excepting lot heretofore conveyed by us to Edward F. Cranford and Lois W. Cranford, dated January 13, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 519, at page 33.

ALSO all that piece, parcel or lot of land, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., containing 2.96 acres, more or less, lying Northeast of and adjacent to the tract of land first above described and having according to a survey made by T. T. Dill, Surveyor, July, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the 8.50 acre tract of 13 land now or formerly belonging to Edwin B. Wynn and Fred W. Wynn, and running thence along the line of said property, S 58-0 W, 747 fect to a hickory; thence N 32 W, 199 feet to an iron pin; thence N 66-00 E, 860 feet to an iron pin; thence S 10-0 E, 133 feet to the beginning corner.
