This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions:

- (1) That no mercantile establishment, other than those already in existence, shall be erected, operated or maintained on the lot above described.
- (2) That only one residence shall be erected or maintained on any one lot.
- (3) That no livestock, except fowl, may be kept, stabled or penned thereon or brought to the premises.

This conveyance is also subject to certain right-of ways, reservations and easements as shown in Vol. 444, at page 325.

The grantee expressly assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on a certain note and mortgage executed by William H. Foster, Jr. and Beatrice C. Foster in the original sum of \$2,475.00 to General Mortgage Co., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 513, at page 262. This mortgage has been assigned to The Hanover Bank, a New York corporation, as Trustee under Deed of Trust dated January 1, 1948, on which there is a balance due of approximately \$1,891.87.
