

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 48 on plat of Knollwood of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book EE, Page 35, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeastern side of Meyers Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots 48 and 49 and running thence S. 62-58 E. 289.5 feet along the line of Lot No. 49 to the rear corner thereof, thence S. 9-33 W. 92.1 feet along the rear line of Lot No. 48 to the corner of Lot No. 47, thence N. 62-58 W. 317 feet along the line of Lot No. 47 to the front corner thereof on Neyers Drive, thence N. 27-02.
