containing 17.2 acres as recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 129, at page 230, but no other deeds have ever been made under this Decree of Court, nor has the Decree itself ever been recorded.

The proceeding referred to was a partition in kind of the estate of W. H. Owens, deceased, and each child went into possession of the tract of land assigned to him or her and have been in continuous possession since December, 1928.
