PROTECTIVE COVENANTS APPLICABLE TO COUNTY OF GREENVILLE ) PROPERTY OWNED BY B. E. RUFF

LHEREAS, there is situate in the County of Greenville, a tract of land comprising three lots owned and being developed into building lots by B. E. Huff; and

EHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the developer of said property, that said property be subdivided and sold by lots;

WHE LEAS, it is the desire and intent of the developer of said property, that the entire projecty and each lot thereof be restricted as to use, location and character of buildin thereon, and as to all other things necessary to create and maintain a comprehensive scheme of desirable home sites, and to create and maintain a residential area that will be free of obnoxious uses and overcrowding or land; have adequate open spaces and yards; and have permanent mutual protection of values and amentics.

- NO: THEREFORE, to achieve these ends, the following conditions and covenants are hereby imposed upon the property as shown on the Plat thereof prepared by J. C. mill, Ireenville, S. J. dated April 6th, 1936, and recorded in the Office of the resister of Mosne Conveyance for Greenville Jounty in Flat Fook LL, at pame 91.

ARTICLL I. Restrictions and Covenants. No land shall be used or occupied and no structure built with said sundivision except in conformance with the following:

- A. We building or starcture shall be located upon any lot closer than fifty feet from the front lot line.
- F. There shall be no residence or dwellin- constructed on sai! lots having less than 1200 feet minimum floor space.
- C. No trailor shall be occupied upon any lot for slaeping or iwelling purposes. To obnovious or offensive activit shall be carried on, nor shall anothing be done which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood. No garage apartments shall be built on the above mentioned property. No apartment houses shall be built on the above mentioned property.

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
