

All that lot of land lying in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Vaughn's Creek near Lake Lanier containing .09 acres, more or less, as shown on a Plat made by the Harwood-Beebe Company in August, 1952, for Landrum, South Carolina, Water Works Improvements,

BEGINNING At a point in the center of Vaughn's Creek approximately 50 feet South of the bridge of the Lake Lanier Road crossing Vaughn's Creek and running thence South 76 degrees 0 minutes West 30 feet; thence South 26 degrees 51 minutes East 146 feet; thence North 47 degrees 44 minutes East to the center of Vaughn's Creek; thence down the center line of the Creek to the BEGINNING point. The property is bounded on the East by a small lot conveyed by the heirs of J.E. Morgan to the Town of Landrum.
