East 200 feet to a stake with witnesses, said stake standing South 23 deg. 45 min. East 129 feet from an iron pin; thence South 23 deg. 45 min. East 179 feet to the BEGINNING, containing 10.6 acres, as shown on a Plat entitled "Land Survey for Julian Calhoun in Gr'ville Co. S.C. Proposed sale to William T. Roff and Lillian E.
